*Local Playing Conditions***48. 2C Grade: Special Conditions**

- a.) Hours of Play: 12.30pm - 6.00pm provided both sides have completed their innings. For matches outside Daylight saving hours, the start and finish times will be brought forward by 30 minutes. There will be a 20 minute tea interval between innings. Should an innings end or there is a stoppage caused by poor weather or bad light within 30 minutes of the agreed time for the tea interval then tea should be taken immediately and shall include the 20-minute tea interval between innings.
- b.) Format: Each innings is 45 overs with a maximum of 9 overs per bowler

49. No Ball (Condition 15 of Section 2 also applies)

If the ball passes or would have passed above the shoulder height of the striker standing upright at the crease the Umpire shall call and signal “no ball”.

50. Overs

In all matches the one innings of each side shall be restricted to 40 overs, with no bowler being permitted to bowl more than 8 overs in the opposing side’s innings.

Points

Win	5 points
Loss	0 points
Tie or abandoned	3 points

Points for win by Default

Where a team wins by default, points awarded to such team for that win shall be the equivalent of the maximum points gained by any other team in that grade and in that round.

Where two teams agree (with the consent of the CCA/CSCA) to defer a match to an alternative date(s), that particular match must be played under the same terms and conditions as the round of play in that grade which the game was originally scheduled.

Presidents Grade – Special Conditions

51. Draw

In Presidents Grade there will be one complete round of matches including the postponed games being rescheduled at the end of the first round. The draw will continue by repeating the first round. The winner will be the team which has the highest number of points at the end of the season.

52. Age Guidelines

In Presidents Grade all teams must take the fields with **at least nine players** over the age of 35. If a team is unable to comply with this condition, then that team's Captain, or his deputy, must gain consent of the opposing captain, or his deputy, by noon on the day preceding the match or the morning of the match. Failure to comply with these conditions will mean loss of points for the match concerned.

53. Late Arrival

If a player arrives late to a men's afternoon grade match, the player can fully participate in the match from the moment the player enters the field of play, regardless of whether the player is a batsman or bowler.

4th GRADE

Dress: For all Fourth Grade teams, provided the team wears a uniform dress, alternate clothing of a sporting nature can be worn, i.e. whites are not compulsory but can be worn. Matching track pants and shirts can be worn. However, a tidy standard of dress is requested.
