Canterbury Cricket is committed to being the leader in identifying and developing people to perform at the highest level of international cricket for the BLACKCAPS and WHITE FERNS. This commitment starts and finishes with our philosophy in identifying the right people, and the quality training environments we foster.

Purpose

The purpose of this Policy is to provide a level of clarity and transparency in directing the selection of all senior representative performance teams and squads for Canterbury Cricket. This policy will also apply to the selection of the Canterbury Cricket contracted players each season.





Procedure

This policy and procedure shall be maintained and approved in respect of accuracy, completeness and relevance by the Chief Executive and the General Manager – Performance



Confirmation

The Chief Executive of Canterbury Cricket shall confirm this policy and procedure is conforming to the requirements of the organisation



Annual Review

This Policy shall be reviewed annually and at times when significant events require changes to be made to this document

Policy

Canterbury Cricket is committed to transparent, well planned and consistent selection of all representative performance teams and squads. This document sets out the policy and procedures adopted by Canterbury Cricket for effective process in selection of senior men and senior women representative sides.

The respective Convenors, after consultation with the panel, shall recommend the names of the Captain and Vice-Captain of the Senior Men's and Women's representative teams to the General Manager - Performance, who will then seek the approval of the Chief Executive. This will also be the process with the selection and approval for Canterbury Cricket Men's and Women's Domestic Contracts.

The Board will be kept updated on any proposed domestic contract list by the Chief Executive (or in their absence the General Manager-Performance) given advance notice of the public announcement.

The Head Coach is solely responsible for selecting and naming the 12th man during all fixtures. This should be completed as early as possible on the morning of the match, or sooner if necessary or already conclusive.

While the captains of each team are not directly involved in the selection of the playing squad, they will play an important role in the discussion and finalisation of the playing XI.

The CCA High Performance Development Coach, CCA Talent and Transition Lead, and CCA Talent Scouts aim to watch significant amounts of Club, School, and/or District Cricket. However, Canterbury Cricket will seek to use identified Club, School, and District Association Coaches to assist with the scouting of CCA Players of Interest and emerging talent.

In addition to selection input, the CCA Talent and Transition Lead and CCA Talent Scouts will attend a series of scheduled scouting checkpoint meetings throughout the domestic season to summarise the players viewed thus far, as well as their perceived form and readiness for Canterbury selection.

The programme Head Coaches will lead the selection of winter training squads and other specialist performance squads, with support from the High-Performance Development Coach (male), CCA Talent and Transition Lead, and Female Pathways Coach. The Panel will determine the numbers of any offseason preparation squads.

In addition to selection input, the CCA Talent and Transition Lead and CCA Talent Scouts will attend a series of scheduled scouting checkpoint meetings throughout the domestic season to summarise the players viewed thus far, as well as their perceived form and readiness for Canterbury selection.

The programme Head Coaches will lead the selection of winter training squads and other specialist performance squads, with support from the High-Performance Development Coach (male), CCA Talent and Transition Lead, and Female Pathways Coach. The Panel will determine the numbers of any offseason preparation squads.

Selection Philosophy and Criteria

Every team selected for Canterbury is selected to win on the field. Canterbury teams win in the right way, with COURAGE, RESPECT and INTEGRITY as inspirational leaders and role models of the game in our region.

Selection will be determined by the outlined criteria and the perceived best team available for any fixture based on all game related factors; format, conditions, opposition, team balance, player health and wellbeing, previous player performance. Consideration is also given to the long-term development and learning opportunities for every player.

If at any stage there is a borderline selection decision between two players, selection weighting will be shifted to the player perceived as having the higher performance potential in respect to international honours.

Significant and consistent performances are a key factor in any selection. However alongside relevant statistics, execution of individual role in the team and progress against areas of identified development are also factors to consider.

SELECTION COMMUNICATION

Management Communication

The Head of Selection will communicate with staff via Teamworks and will maintain confidentiality until player communication is complete.

Cricket Operations will use the information for planning as needed, but will not contact players until player communication has been confirmed.

Player Communication

Heads of Selection are expected to communicate with players on selection ideally in person or via phone call (due to time sensitivity on some occasions a personal text might be the only option).

PLAYER OMMITTED: If any player who played in the previous match is to be omitted, the Head of Selection is required to inform him/her of his/her non-selection prior to the team announcement. Reasoning around non-selection should be provided on all occasions, including any areas of potential development if relevant. This is also relevant at start of a campaign.

PLAYER INCLUDED: Head of Selection to communicate to player.

NO CHANGE - PLAYER REMAINS IN TEAM: No communication required.

NO CHANGE – PLAYER REMAINS OUT: No communication required, however could be appropriate on a case by case.
